

Chino Valley FFA Alumni School-To-Work Scholarship

Qualifications and Directions

Qualifications:

1. Applicant must be a senior at Chino Valley High School.
2. Applicant must be an active member of the CVHS Agriculture program and a member of the FFA Organization.
3. Applicant must be planning to further their education after graduation from Chino Valley High School.

Directions:

1. Applicant must use the national FFA Scholarship Application
2. Application must be typed
3. Neatness, grammar and spelling will be considered
4. A cover page with:
 - a. Applicant's Name
 - b. Address
 - c. Phone Number
 - d. The number of years enrolled
 - e. A statement of the Chino Valley FFA Activities that the applicant and their family members have been involved with.
5. Attach two (2) signed and sealed letters of reference. One letter must be from a CVHS Staff Member outside of the agriculture program. The second one must be from a community member other than a family member.
6. Attach an original signed and stamped CVHS transcript.
7. Attach a one (1) page detailed explanation for use of scholarship money awarded and what field you are planning to enter.
8. The complete application and supporting materials must be turned in as one packet.

11. Deadline: Applications must be postmarked by April 1st, 2007. No late applications will be considered.
12. Scholarships will be awarded at the FFA End of the Year Banquet on April 14.
13. Upon being selected to receive a School-To-Work scholarship, the applicant will have a six (6) month period to provide proof of employment. Funds will be awarded at the time when the applicant provides proof of employment.

FFA Alumni School-To-Work Scholarship Reference Letter Directions:

Applicants applying for the School-To-Work Scholarship are asked to provide two (2) letters of reference, one from a CVHS staff member and one from a community member other than a family member.

Reference Letter should include the following:

1. Why the student would benefit from the School-To-Work scholarship.
2. Description of the student's personal reliability and social ability
3. Please indicate how long and in what capacity you have known this student.
4. Writers name, address, and phone number.

Please place in sealed envelope with applicant's name on the front and writers signature across the seal

Please return to applicant to be turned in with other parts of the application.
